

Xtreme K-9 Rules and Regulations

To ensure the safety and health of all animals and staff at Xtreme K-9, we require all clients to comply with the following Rules and Regulations:

SEX: All dogs must be spayed or neutered (unless they are under 6 months of age) for daycare clients.

SHOTS: All dogs must have up-to-date vaccinations. Parents must submit written verification that their dogs have current DHLPP, Rabies and Kennel Cough (recommended) vaccinations. *Specifically the vaccines required are Distemper, Hepatitis, Leptospirosis, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus, and Rabies.. You will receive reminders when vaccinations are due. It is your responsibility to provide on-going verification of current vaccinations.*

HEALTH: All dogs must be in good health. Parents will need to certify that their dogs are in good health and have been free from any condition that could potentially jeopardize other guests. **Dogs that have been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days will require veterinarian certification of health to be admitted or readmitted.** If, at any time during care, a dog is noticed to have fleas or ticks, treatment will be applied and charged to the parent at the minimum rate of \$30.00. All dogs will be examined for signs of fleas and ticks at check in and **will not** be admitted to day care if fleas or signs of fleas or ticks are noticed. This “spot check” is not a foolproof process; therefore, Xtreme K-9 requires a flea and parasite preventative, excluding flea/tick collars. Product suggestions: Sentinel, Top Spot (Frontline), or Program.

QUICK RELEASE COLLARS: Recommended with nametags. RETRACTABLE LEASHES are not allowed.

FOOD: All food brought to Xtreme K-9 must be stored in an airtight/rodent proof container. Opened dog food bags are not acceptable.

BEHAVIOR: All dogs must pass the Xtreme K-9 Proprietary Behavior Assessment for enrollment in our program. All dogs must be non-aggressive and not food or toy protective. Parents will need to certify that their dog(s) have not harmed or shown any aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog(s). Please remember that your pet will be spending time with other pets and that their safety and health is our main priority. **Keep in mind, although it is supervised play, your dog still might acquire an occasional nip or scratch.**

AGE: Any age dog/puppy is allowed at Xtreme K-9 as long as the dog/puppy meets the Xtreme K-9 criteria. Puppies may begin Xtreme K-9 before they receive their Rabies vaccine and before they are spayed/neutered, as long as both will be taken care of by 6 months of age.

ENROLLMENT: All dogs must have a complete, up-to-date and approved enrollment form on file. If your dog has been out of day care for two months or more, re-assessment is required and fees will be applied. **ALL Xtreme K-9 FORMS MUST BE SIGNED BY PARENT BEFORE ENROLLMENT.**

FEES: Due and payable at the end of each day. Cash, check or credit is accepted. Discounted packages are provided only if they are paid in advance. Pre-paid packages are non-refundable. Barks Pack expires the last day of each month. Our program is flexible enough to accommodate reasonable special needs requests; however, appropriate fees will be applied. Current Credit Card number and expiration date must be on file at all times. Please see rate card for all fee details.

HOURS OF OPERATION: Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Drop off and pick up any time during these hours, except during nap time (11:00am to 3:00 p.m.). Weekend and holidays may vary with drop off and pick up at specified times only. *Xtreme K-9 closes promptly at 6:00 p.m. M-F. Late charges of \$.50 per minute will be applied. Additional late fees may vary.

RESERVATIONS: Required. **Cancellations not made by 6:00 p.m. one business day prior to the scheduled day care day will be charged full fees and invoiced to the parent. Cancellations not made by 6:00 p.m. one business day prior to the scheduled sleepover will be charged half the scheduled sleepover amount (excluding holidays where the full amount will be charged).**

Xtreme K-9 Client Agreement

For myself, my heirs and any assigns, I hereby release Xtreme K-9 (from here on in known as XK9), its agents, officers, subcontractors, employees, animal parents, customers and potential customers of from any and all liabilities for injuries to myself, my dog, or any other property of mine which arise in any way out of services and/or products provided by or as a consequence of my association with Xk9. I acknowledge and understand that every dog reacts differently and that animals, by nature are unpredictable.

Dogs and animals may, without warning, bite or cause injury to humans and other dogs. I acknowledge and understand that there are certain risks involved in participating in day care, including but not limited to dog fights, dog bites to humans or other dogs and the transmission of disease.

In the case of emergency or for the use of the Canine Cab services, I recognize the risks of injury that accompany said transport and acknowledge that this RELEASE is being relied upon by Xk9 to permit transport of my pet to and from Xk9 or any other necessary location. Furthermore, I accept any and all conditions, rules and regulations promulgated by Xk9 associated with the activities, use of the facilities and transport, and hereby agree to comply with them.

Read and initial each line below:

- ____ Dogs not familiar with Xk9 may experience separation anxiety when apart from their human companions.
- ____ Dogs not regularly exposed to the level of activity at Xk9 may feel the discomfort of sore muscles, sore joints and fatigue.
- ____ Dogs not regularly exposed to outside activity or play on hard surfaces may experience sore paws, blisters, bruises or abrasions on the feet (Raw Paw).
- ____ Dogs not regularly socialized do not necessarily know how to behave politely with other dogs. These dogs are at higher risk of Incidents including, but not limited to, bites, fights, fear aggression, behavior problems and/or acting out.
- ____ Dogs at play during the regular day care do get dirty. Dogs with longer hair can get matted from the level of activity at day care. Baths and brush outs can be requested and scheduled.
- ____ Excessively long toenails may cause injury. You will be notified if your dog's nails are too long. If, at your next visit, the nails have not been trimmed, Xk9 will have them trimmed at parent's expense.
- ____ I understand the extra risks my puppy has of contracting disease or illness by entering the day care program without being fully vaccinated.
- ____ Water is available at all times; however, your dog may still be thirsty after day care. Be aware of their water intake as excessive amounts may cause an upset stomach or other problems.
- ____ Dramatic changes in food and/or food quality may cause upset stomachs, diarrhea, and/or colitis.
- ____ Any behavior deemed dangerous or inappropriate by Xk9 may result in dismissal from the program.
- ____ I agree to pay for all services due at the time they are rendered. I understand any unpaid fees by me will be sent to _____ collections and I will be responsible for all collections and legal fees incurred by such actions taken.
- ____ I understand and agree that in admitting my dog(s) into Xk9, Xk9 has relied on my representation that my dog(s) have not harmed or shown aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog.
- ____ I certify that my dog(s) is/are in good health and has/have not been ill with any communicable disease within the last 30 days.
- ____ I have read and understand the Xk9 "Rules and Regulations."
- ____ I understand Xk9 staff gives all pets involved in any type of incident a cursory examination, however, Xk9 is not liable for the location, treatment or diagnosis of any injuries incurred on our premises. It is recommended you check your dog further or seek treatment for your pet by a licensed veterinarian at your discretion and cost.

I, _____ grant Xk9 and/or its selected agents full power of decision concerning the care and well being of our dog(s). Should any medical emergency arise, it is agreed that Xk9 or its selected Agents can and will make any needed decision concerning medical treatment and choice of care giver up to \$ _____.
